Normal lymphocyte count in blood. The normal levels of lymphocytes present in the blood usually range between 1200 and 3200 lymphocytes per milliliter of blood. However, it may be noted that different laboratories may follow different standards of valuing the normal levels of lymphocytes.

In this case, all ranges are expressed in percentages and ALC (absolute Lymphocyte count): 0 to 6 days old: lymphocyte 26 - 36% (2000 - 11000 ALC) 7 to 13 days old : lymphocyte 36 - 46% (2000 - 17000 ALC)

What Is The Normal Range Of Lymphocyte Count

A count significantly higher than 3,000 lymphocytes in a microliter of blood is generally considered to be lymphocytosis in adults. In children, the threshold for lymphocytosis varies with age. It can be as high as 9,000 lymphocytes per microliter. The exact thresholds for lymphocytosis can vary slightly from one lab to another.

Lymphocyte levels can be determined and analyzed through a blood test. The range value is calculated per milliliter of blood, and the normal range for lymphocytes is typically between 1,300 and 4,000 cells per milliliter.

Low Lymphocyte Count (Lymphocytopenia)

There are three main types of lymphocytes: B cells, T cells, and natural killer (NK) cells. Lymphocytes compose approximately 15 to 40% of the total white blood cells in the body. In a healthy adult a lymphocyte count of 1000 - 4800 cells per microliter of blood is considered the normal range.

You can have a higher than normal lymphocyte count but have few, if any, symptoms. It usually occurs after an illness and is harmless and temporary. But it might represent something more serious, such as a blood cancer or a chronic infection. Your doctor might perform other tests to determine if your lymphocyte count is a cause for concern.

The mean relative lymphocyte count by automated method was 73.6% as compared to 75.6% by the manual method. The mean absolute lymphocyte count by automated method was 32.1×10^3 / μ L as opposed to 32.9×10^3 / μ L by the manual method.

A lymphocyte count is usually part of a peripheral complete blood cell count and is expressed as the percentage of lymphocytes to the total number of white blood cells counted. A general increase in the number of lymphocytes is known as lymphocytosis , [13] whereas a decrease is known as lymphocytopenia .
